

What is the SAT Foundation?

The Sylvia Ann Thornton Foundation is a charitable organization established to assist families choosing to keep their loved ones with Down syndrome in a home health environment, but who might be facing challenges like aging caregivers and gaps in funding for services. The mission of SAT Foundation is to improve the quality of life for adults with Down syndrome by providing funds for services that support in-home care. SAT's vision is that, with this support, adults with Down syndrome will be able to continue to live fulfilling lives in their homes and local communities. The foundation is named for Sylvia Ann Thornton, who has been living with Down syndrome since her birth in 1953.
